Healing Pathway Phase 1

Phase 1 is an introduction to the basic concepts of Christ-centred healing techniques within the Christian tradition, with an emphasis on learning to be a healing presence and conduit of God's healing power. This workshop includes the following:

Content...

- ◆ The primary principles for a healing ministry.
- ◆ The traditional, scriptural and spiritual sources of Christian-centred healing.
- ◆ Review of the Healing Pathway Code of Ethics.
- ◆ The elements of self-care.
- ◆ Centring and grounding through prayer and meditation.
- ◆ Experiencing being a heart-centred instrument of healing.
- ◆ Introduction to a Healing Sequence and specific healing techniques.
- ◆ The application of a ministry of healing within the church and community.
